HOW TO GET TO CORDOBA

By Air

Nearest Airports to Córdoba:

Córdoba does not have its own major international airport. The two closest major airports are:

Seville Airport (SVQ) – ~1.5 hours by train

Málaga Airport (AGP) – ~1.5 to 2 hours by train

From Seville or Málaga to Córdoba:

You can take a high-speed train (AVE) from both cities. Trains are frequent and take approximately 45 minutes from Seville and 1 hour from Málaga.

By Train

Córdoba is well-connected by Spain's Renfe high-speed rail network.

Córdoba Central Station is the main station, serving routes between:

Madrid ⇌ Córdoba (approx. 1 hour 45 minutes)

Seville ⇌ Córdoba (approx. 45 minutes)

Málaga ⇌ Córdoba (approx. 1 hour)

Barcelona ⇌ Córdoba (approx. 4.5–5 hours)

By Bus

Several national and international buses also operate to Córdoba:

ALSA offers direct connections from major Spanish cities like Madrid, Granada, Seville, and Málaga.

International buses might arrive in Madrid or Málaga first, where you can transfer to a train or domestic bus.

Córdoba Bus Station is located next to the train station and is well connected to the rest of the city.

It is mandatory for participants to find the most cost-effective travel option from their current location to the project site. Detailed information about transportation to the accommodation will be provided through the project's Facebook group. **Additionally, participants are obligated to confirm their tickets with us before purchasing.**

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Córdoba is a compact and walkable city, but also offers a convenient and reliable public transportation system for longer distances.

Local Buses

Córdoba's bus system is operated by AUCORSA and covers most areas of the city, including the train and bus stations, historical center, and residential neighborhoods.

Buses run from approximately 6:30 AM to 11:00 PM, with limited night service on some lines.

You can buy a single ticket from the driver (cash only) or use rechargeable travel cards available at kiosks.

Main bus stops display route information and estimated arrival times.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation is usually arranged in hostels, and details will be shared with you through our official communication channels. It is important to stay updated via WhatsApp, email, or other platforms we use, as key information about your stay may be shared there. Please check these regularly to avoid missing important announcements or last-minute changes. Hostels offer a budget-friendly and social environment, with basic facilities provided. If you have specific personal items you would like to bring for your comfort, feel free to do so. You will receive three meals per day—breakfast, lunch, and dinner—for the duration of the program.

CURRENCY EXCHANGE LOCATIONS

Banks

Major Spanish banks such as BBVA, CaixaBank, and Santander operate branches in Córdoba. Many of them offer currency exchange services, usually during regular banking hours (Monday to Friday, 8:30 AM – 2:00 PM). It's advisable to bring your passport for identification.

Currency Exchange Offices

While Córdoba has fewer dedicated exchange offices than Madrid, you can find some in central or tourist-frequented areas. Be sure to compare rates and ask about commission fees before exchanging.

ATMs

The easiest and most accessible way to obtain euros is through ATMs, which are widely available across the city. Most accept international debit and credit cards. This method typically provides favorable exchange rates, but check with your home bank about foreign transaction or withdrawal fees.
