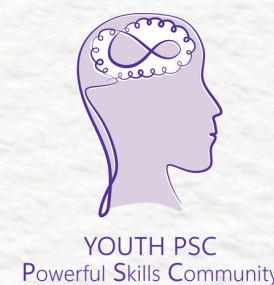


Make Gender Equality a Value, Not a Priority

About the project:

Gender equality is still not a reality. Across Europe and beyond, people of all genders face unequal opportunities, expectations, and limitations shaped by social norms, stereotypes, and power structures. These inequalities affect education, employment, participation in decision-making, personal freedom, and everyday life. Promoting gender equality is a fundamental value of the European Union and a shared responsibility of all citizens.

This Youth Exchange provides young people with the opportunity to explore gender equality through non-formal education. Daily activities and problem-solving situations will serve as practical examples to reflect on equality, power relations, cooperation, and shared responsibility in real-life contexts.

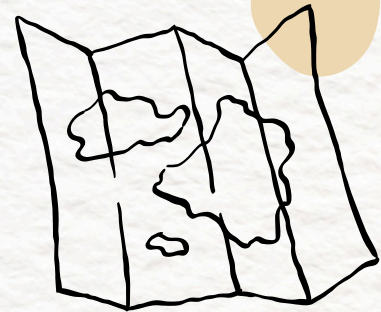
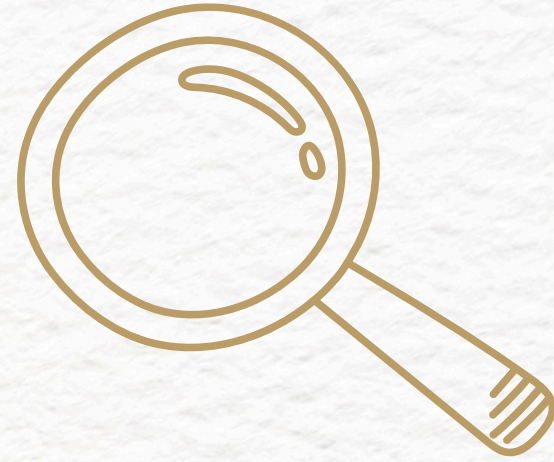
The programme will include a wide range of interactive activities such as workshops, discussions, simulations, and reflection sessions. These activities aim to promote core values, such as respect, equality, inclusion, solidarity, empathy, cooperation, and mutual understanding, while encouraging active participation, open dialogue, and critical thinking.

Participants will have the opportunity to meet and engage with policymakers, stakeholders, and organisations working in the field of gender equality and human rights. These encounters will help participants connect their learning experience with real-world practices, policies, and initiatives at local, national, and European levels.

Throughout the exchange, a safe, inclusive, and supportive learning environment will be created, where all participants are encouraged to express themselves freely, share experiences, and learn from one another, respecting diversity and different perspectives. The project aims to inspire young people to question existing social norms, imagine more inclusive ways of living together, and take concrete action to promote gender-sensitive and inclusive practices within their communities.

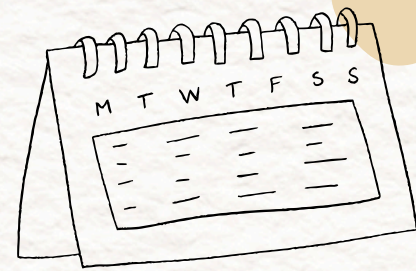

Participants' Profile:

- Age: 18-30 years old (Group leaders 18+)
- Basic or good knowledge of English
- Interested in issues related to gender equality, human rights, social justice, and active citizenship.
- Willing to fully participate and contribute to project activities
- Knowledge Sharing / Dissemination: Ready to spread what they learn about the project

Team leaders will be responsible for their group and their needs, and will help facilitate the whole project by giving advice, and coordinating communication between us, the project organizers, and the participants

Venue:

The youth exchange will take place at the Journalistic Village in Pervolia. This accommodation is situated near the beach, and the apartments are furnished with a private bathroom, a kitchen equipped with a fridge, air conditioning, and central Wi-Fi.

The venue consists of small flats with 1 or 2 bedrooms. Each flat can accommodate 4-7 people. Towels and linen are provided; however, you need to bring your own toiletries.

The location has a spacious activity room designated for the workshops, as well as a restaurant, which will provide all the meals throughout the day and snacks during snack breaks.

Travel Costs:

The Erasmus+ programme fully funds this youth exchange. Accommodation and meals are only provided during the official project dates. If you plan to stay extra days before or after the project, you are responsible for arranging and covering your own accommodations and meals.

- Your journey must start from your home country.
- Only the most economical means of transport (economy class fares) are eligible for reimbursement.
- The project budget does NOT cover: taxi, private transportation, gas, personal car use, car rental, Parking fees, Personal expenses
- Renting and using a car during the project dates is strictly forbidden.
- Full attendance throughout the entire project is required in order to receive reimbursement.
- **DO NOT** buy any travel tickets without receiving prior confirmation from the project coordinator (Youth PSC - youthpsc24@gmail.com)

To receive travel cost reimbursement, participants must:

- Keep and send ALL original travel documents (Invoices, Tickets, Boarding passes).
- Fulfill dissemination requirements.
- Complete the Mobility Tool+ (group leaders).

Reimbursement will be made via bank transfer to the **sending organisation** after all conditions are met.

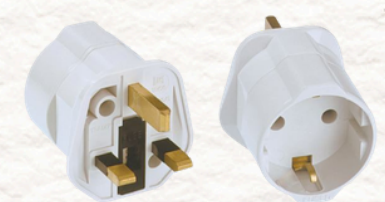


Travel Info:

The closest airport to the venue is Larnaca Airport.

Paphos Airport is also an option, but getting to the venue from there is more challenging.

*Note that Ercan Airport in the Northern part of Cyprus is not covered by the European Union for travel expenses. Therefore, we request that you book flights to either Larnaca or Paphos, as these are the only two legal airports in Cyprus that are eligible for reimbursement



What to bring:

- Original tickets, boarding passes, passports
- European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)
- Personal medication
- Power adaptors suitable for Cyprus' 240 Volt/50Hz, with 3-pin electricity plus socket
- National products for the Intercultural Nights and other materials
- Comfortable clothing and shoes, swimsuit, beach towel
- Personal care products (shampoo, comb, hairdryer)
- Mosquito Repellent
- Sunscreen
- A laptop per country (for workshops and intercultural nights)
- Most importantly, bring positive vibes and lots of enthusiasm!
